**Judge Morris Silberman** received his undergraduate degree from Tulane University, majoring in philosophy and political science. He received his J.D. degree from the University of Florida College of Law in 1982. Judge Silberman was appointed to the Second District Court of Appeal by Governor Jeb Bush and began serving as a member of the Court on January 2, 2001.

**Judge Craig Villanti** received his B.A. degree in 1974 in political science from the State University of New York at Binghamton, where he attended on a New York State Regent's Scholarship Award. He received his J.D. degree from Stetson University College of Law in 1977. In 1992 Judge Villanti was elected circuit court judge for the Sixth Judicial Circuit. He was re-elected without opposition in 1998. After an initial one-year assignment in Pinellas County, he served in Pasco County until his appointment to the Second District Court of Appeal in February 2003 by Governor Jeb Bush.
